INSTALLATION PROCEDURES FOR WALL-MOUNTED MIRRORS

Choose the location in which you wish to install the mirror. Make sure that there are no hidden electrical cables or pipes in the wall. If cables or pipes are found mark their position so as not to cause damage to them. When installed your mirror should be at a height and location that best serves your needs.

This product is supplied with wall mounting screws and plastic inserts. If your mirror is being installed in a location where it is not suitable to use this type of screw and insert you should check with a building supply or hardware store for the correct type of hardware to use for your wall type.

Hold the mirror against the wall in the location that you wish final installation to be. Following the edge of the mirror draw a faint line down one edge and along the bottom of the mirror (it is advisable to use a pencil or similar so that the lines can be easily removed once installation is complete). Measure from the edge and bottom of the mirror to the centre of the two fixing brackets on the back of the mirror and transfer these measurements onto the wall so that there are two marks (showing the centre of the fixing brackets) on the wall where holes need to be drilled.

Drill two holes using a suitable size and type drill bit. Push the plastic inserts into the holes and screw in the mounting screws. Try to fit the mirror onto the mounting screws by locating the mounting screws into the fixing brackets (the mounting screws can be adjusted for length by screwing into or out of the wall as required).

To finish installation position the mirror back onto the wall and locate on the mounting screws.
